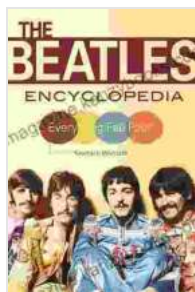

The Early Years

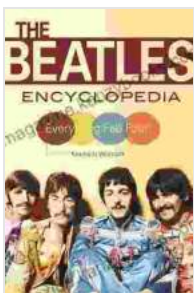
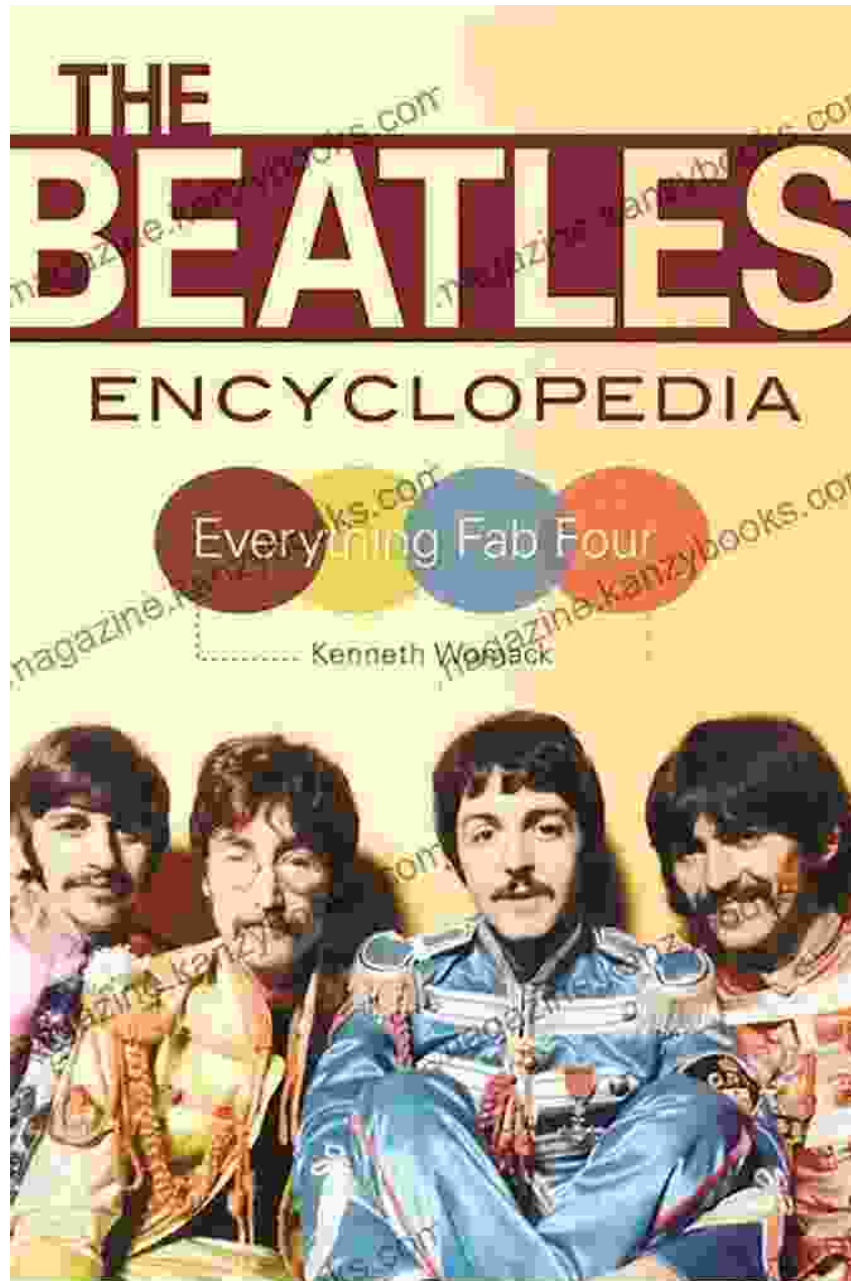

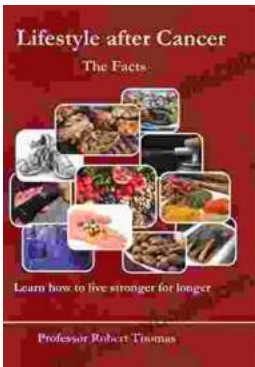
